Evolution Definitions

- **Evolution**—The gradual process of change that occurs in populations of organisms over a long period of time. It manifests itself as new characteristics in a species, and the *formation of new species*. ^{Bib 34 p117}
- **Species**—One population of organisms, all the members of which are able to breed amongst themselves or through artificial insemination and are able to produce fertile offspring. ^{Bib 34 p305}

Microevolution—The change of traits within a species.

- Natural Selection (In nature)—The breeding process in nature by which organisms adapt and produce changes in traits *within a species*.
- Selective Breeding (Domesticated)—The process of breeding organisms for specific characteristics that produce desired traits within a species.
- Adaptation—The change of traits within a species in nature or domesticated species.
- Macroevolution—The theoretical change of a species into a new species.
 - Speciation—The formation of one or more new species from an existing species. Bib 34 p305





My Brethren and Sisters:—Throughout the discussion of this topic, I would like you to keep in mind the following passages of scripture:

For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth; but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned (I Cor. 2:11-14).

Then I beheld all the work of God, that a man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun: because though a man labor to seek it out, yet he shall not find it; yea further; though a wise man think to know it, yet shall he not be able to find it (Ecclesiastes 8:17).

The great difficulty with most scientists is that they are searching to find out God and all his works through the spirit of man, which knows not the ways of the Lord which are spiritually discerned. No man by searching, without the inspiration of the Holy Ghost, can find out God. It is the holy Priesthood that "holdeth the key of the mysteries of the kingdom even the key of the knowledge of God; therefore, in the ordinances thereof, the power of godliness is manifest; and without the ordinances thereof, and the authority of the Priest-



There never was a "prehistoric man," in the sense that he was part man and part something else. No such creature ever existed in this or any other world. He or it exists only in the minds of men who refuse the truth and have a theory of their own that is utterly false - contrary to the revealed word of God. 
